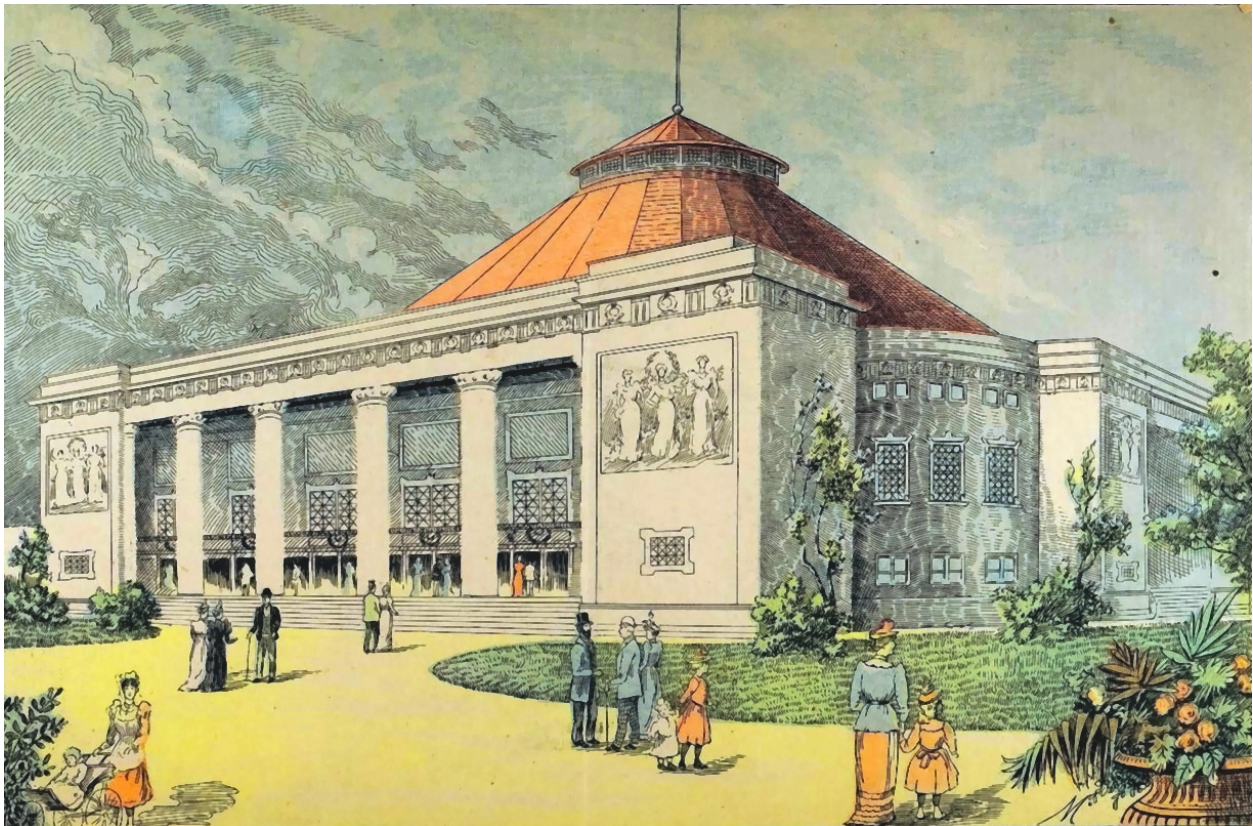

National Union Day, August 2, 1893 at the World's Columbian Exposition, Chicago

With music, oratory, and fireworks the secret order of the National Union observed its special day at the Fair. Every council in Chicago was largely represented, and many members of lodges throughout the country were in attendance at the ceremonies in Festival Hall at 3 pm. The principal speaker was Mr. M. G. Jeffris, of Wisconsin, who reviewed the growth of the National Union, speaking of the patriotic features of the order and the good it was doing in the inculcation of true American sentiments.
