Brazil Day, September 7, 1893

at the World's Columbian Exposition, Chicago.

The Brazilian Commissioners celebrated the achievement of their country's independence from Portugal on September 7, 1822, by keeping open house all day. Rear-Admiral Cordovil Maurity, the newly appointed President of the Brazilian Commission, received the visitors. A concert was given in the Music Hall at 2 o'clock pm under the direction of Carlos Gomez, the Brazilian composer, the program consisting entirely of selections from operas of Gomez.
