Millers Day, June 29, 1893

at the World's Columbian Exposition, Chicago



Two hundred representative millers, from all parts of the United States, met on this day in the Assembly Room of the World's Columbian Commission in Pavilion A, Administration Building.

The principal address was made by ex-Governor Edward O. Stannard, of St. Louis, chairman of the meeting, in which the development of the milling industry in this country since the importation of the first millstone, in 1628, was reviewed. General John W. Noble, ex-Secretary of the Interior, then made a brief address.
