# Stenographers' Day, July 22, 1893 at the World's Columbian Exposition, Chicago

The World's Congress of Stenographers closed its session in Chicago with a day at the Fair. A program, including speeches by members of the profession, was arranged for an afternoon meeting at Music Hall. Isaac S. Dement, of Chicago, vice-president of the congress, presided.

The principal address was made by Mr. H. K. Souder, of Akron, Ohio, in which he gave a brief account of the invention and development of stenography. This meeting was followed by a reception at the Woman's Building, under the auspices of the National Association of Woman Stenographers. The company was addressed by Mrs. May Wright Sewall and others. About a thousand stenographers, from all parts of the country, took part in the proceedings.
