Village of East Wenona, Illinois

The Village of East Wenona was a village in Osage Township, LaSalle County, Illinois. East Wenona was located on the eastern border of the city of Wenona (Wenona was incorporated in 1859) which is in Marshall County.



The village was incorporated on May 7, 1908, and had a population of 367 in 1910 and 333 in 1920. The post office address was in Wenona. Between 1925 and 1927 the village of East Wenona was annexed by Wenona.
